That's why we are excited to once again host our Annual School Supply Drive, which kicked off at our Back to School Event cohosted by The Community Clothes Closet with over 200 students receiving both new clothes and school supplies!

THE NUTRITION MISSION EXPANDS REACH

GROWING WITH GOODNESS

The Compassionate Connections Center is proud to announce a meaningful expansion of our Nutrition Mission Program now serving 300 children each week—a 20% increase from last year's total of 250.

This program provides nutritious, easy-to-prepare food for children who may not have consistent access to meals over the weekend when school meals are not available. Each backpack is filled with two breakfast items , two lunch items, snacks and vouchers for bread and milk to help ensure students return to school on Monday nourished and ready to learn.



The rising need reflects both the economic challenges families are facing and the importance of programs that fill critical gaps. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, volunteers, and community partners, we've been able to meet the growing demand and reach more children than ever before.

Every backpack is more than just a meal—it's a message of care and stability for a child in need. With your continued support, we can ensure that no child in our community goes hungry over the weekend.
